SAN Event Items

Ticket Sales:

33 tickets have been sold at school since the last meeting.

12/17/10 is last day for the reduced price of \$30 and entry into the \$50 drawing. The drawing will be held at the next SAN meeting.

Two students have been presented for financial need. It was voted to provide scholarships to these and other students with financial need. Those interested in purchasing a ticket for these students or donating to a scholarship fund should e-mail Jerry Emoto.

Jerry will ask the counselors if there are other students who may have financial need. If they have the ability to pay some they may be asked to pay a reduced ticket price. It was also suggested that we might ask the student to consider working a concession stand for a ticket. This would not be a requirement but it could be suggested as a way to participate.

Buying Committee:

Brian reported that the previous year had a mix of approximately 70% actual gifts and 30% gift cards in each price category. It was suggested to consider shifting that mix to 50/50.

Plan to try to have 10-20 big ticket items to be given out at the end of the event.

Suggested budget based on last year's spending is about \$25,000.

Mark Hill reported that the GU concessions are going well. Continue to need parents and students to sign up for games. Volunteers are especially needed for games 12/17, 12/31, and 1/3. Will continue to have sign-ups at the school the week before games and will ask for students phone numbers when they sign up so they can be contacted.

Auction:

The auction is 3/12/11 at Assumption. Dinner will be by Mama Mia's. The owner has agreed to provide the food at the same price as last year.

The next planning meeting is 1/12/11 at Teresa's.

There will be 24 tables of 8 available. Tickets are \$25/person or \$200/table. People are encouraged to 'sponsor' a table and can sign up for that now. Sponsoring a table involves selling the tickets for that table and providing the theme/decorations for your table. You will also need to provide dishes and cutlery for the table.

There will be a silent and live auction. People are encouraged to contact local businesses for donations. See Linda or Teresa if you know of businesses you would like to contact.

There are letters available to give to businesses as an initial contact and also as a receipt for donations. The letters can be found on the website at nchs-san.com. Creative ideas were also suggested such as donating yard work, cookie of the month for one year, day at a lake cabin, etc. Any wine or beer donations will need to be served by Mama Mia's employees to be covered by their liquor license.
