General Items

Proposed budget reviewed and approved.

Ticket Sales:

117 tickets have been sold to date. There was 108 tickets sold this time last year. The goal is to sell 180. Drawing for \$25 gift was held for those who purchased tickets from Christmas break to Spring break – Isabella Pontepencko was the winner.

Discussed cost of tickets and decision made to leave ticket price at \$40 for now. Will decide at the next SAN meeting whether or not to increase price to \$50.

Connie and Dan Johnson set up the display window in the skylight to promote ticket sales.

Jerry will talk with Steve Fiske again about a call to all Sr. parents promoting the SAN. He will also put together a letter to all seniors to promote ticket sales and encourage parents to volunteer for the event.

Chantel Czarpeta will make tickets for the SAN.

Kelly Hawley requested an updated list of those attending the event to make tags for the cinch sacks.

Buying Committee:

Brian presented a list of gifts purchased to date and plan of items yet to be purchased. He asked for assistance purchasing some outdoor/camping type equipment – Jaime Lithco volunteered to help with this.

There was some discussion as to how to distribute the gifts and whether they should be separated by value or have the students select both their \$25 and \$50 at the same time.

Sketch Artist:

It was voted to hire sketch artist for \$500 to do sketches at SAN. Each drawing takes approximately 3 minutes and can have up to 6 students.

Theme Logo Design:

Sketches for logo from Ryan Hare were presented and voted on. The logo will be used on cinch sacks, tickets and volunteer t-shirts.

Event Activities:

The fourth draft of the SAN activities was reviewed. It lists possible locations for each event, number of volunteers needed, and team lead.

We now need volunteers to sign up to help for the various activities. Most areas have 3 shifts available to work.

Food service has some donations lined up including 45 pizzas and half & half. Waiting to hear back on coffee and coffee machine. Checking to see what plates and cups are left from last year. Lilly and Linda will ask grocery stores for donations/gift cards for miscellaneous food items needed for the event. Giant coolers are needed for the event – Lithcos and Ahos will loan these items.

It was decided to have the Big Gifts raffle in the cafeteria at the end of the event.

Rhonda VanHorn has laundry baskets from last year. Need to get a count from her to see how many need to be purchased and make 3x5 cards with names for these.

Decorations will be put up Fri. evening 6/10.

Casino room decorations available from previous years.

Cinch Sacks will be assembled at final SAN meeting and will include a map of activities (Jerry to make), Coffee coupon, Gatorade, and play money.

Rick reported the Minute to Win It activity is coming together. He will be using a computer for the tasks, timer and music. If any one has speakers that would work with a MAC computer please let him know.

Candy bars and raffle tickets will be given to participants.

The game room has air hockey, foosball, and misc board games so far.

Junior parents will be invited to volunteer to help with the event.

Need a hotel room for hypnotist – will check with Rick to see if he was able to get this.
