Treasurer's Report

General Items

Volunteer t-shirts have been received and are available for pick-up for \$5. They will be available at the Information desk the night of the SAN.

Cinch sacks were prepped prior to this meeting.

Gift cards have been given to Sherry Kubik and Kim Puckett thanking them for their assistance with the SAN.

Ryan Hare was given \$25 for SAN logo design.

SAN Event Items

Budget reviewed. It is estimated that after all expenses are paid there will be approximately \$1000 left over. It was voted to divide any balance between NC, the NC Booster club and 2012 SAN and add it to the amount that has already been designated for those groups.

GU Student volunteer awards

Mark has the award envelopes ready and they will be distributed to the students at the SAN registration desk.

Ticket Sales:

162 tickets have been sold to date. 20 scholarships have been awarded. 7 of these have been paid for and donated. The goal is to sell 180.

Any tickets purchased at the door will need verification that the student is a graduating senior. The registration desk will have a list of eligible students.

Buying Committee:

All gift cards have been purchased. All big gifts have been purchased.

There are a total of 97 \$25 real gifts and 96 \$50 gifts. No further purchases will be made at this point. If there are gifts left over they will be raffled at the end of the event along with the big items.

Event Activities:

The Registration team is meeting 6/7/11 to label arm bands and assign times for the gift room and money walk. The registration desk will be located by the East side doors near the cafeteria. A security person will be posted at those doors throughout the event. Anyone entering after 10 will need to check in at the information booth.

Pete Cropper is in charge of Security and will have volunteers posted at various points.

Sara Aho is in charge of the information booth. Students with raffle tickets from the various activities will take them to the information booth to be entered in the drawings. Drawings will be held approximately every 30 minutes and the winners will be posted on a board at the desk.

Food service has received several donations and anticipate expenses to be < \$500. Food items and beverages will be available throughout the event including pizza, sandwiches, chips, hot cookies, ice cream, fruit, and espresso. Thank you Doug and Lori Wordell.
The Aho's will be providing 2 large coolers for ice.

Jennifer Clary is in charge of the Italian Soda and espresso stand. Doug will look at the cups etc left from last year and assess what is needed to be purchased.

Decorating and partial set up will be done Fri starting at 6. The rest of the set up will be done Sat at 6. A few volunteers will be needed Sat evening to help with inflating balloons.

As students visit the tattoo booth, sketch artist and photo booth a colored mark will be put on their wrist bands.

The tattoo booth will be open from 10 pm to 1 am.

Photos will be from 9 pm to 2 am. Waiting to hear from Mr. Armitage about using costumes.

Brian and Carol Thomas requested 4-6 volunteers to help unload the gift items and transport them to the gift room at 6 on Sat. Students will go to the gift room at designated times.

A total of \$3960 will be give out at the money walk. Linda Emoto is in charge of this.

The game room has 2-3 volunteers and will have ping pong and foosball. Paul plans to have some beverages in that area.

Rick has all he needs for Minute to Win It. Thanks to all who brought items.
He has received candy donations with 240 items to be given out at Minute to Win It and Lyric rooms. There is also a 5lb Hershey bar that will be used as a grand prize – possible some kind of final playoff round.

Small laundry baskets were purchased for the holding room .

Students will be sent to the auditorium at 2:30 for the hypnotist. The performance will take about 1 ½ hours. Twelve students will be selected to participate. An AV student will be hired to run the lights and sound.

After the hypnotist students will go to the cafeteria for breakfast and the Big Gift Raffle. Chantel Czarpeta will be in charge of the raffle. Volunteers will be needed at the bottom of the stairs to remove the wrist bands for the raffle.

Each team lead will be responsible for cleaning up their designated area. Will need some junior parents to take decorations etc for next year. Tables will not need to be put away.
