Meeting Notes

- Jerry Emoto welcomed the attendees and described the Senior All-Nighter event and how funds are raised primarily through two activities, the Auction and running concession stands at the Gonzaga University basketball games.
- It was decided that the Senior All-Nighter event would take place at NC, as was done in recent years. It will be on graduation day June 11 from 9pm to 5am.
- There was no decision on how much money we anticipate raising through the fund raising activities. The general thought was that the Auction and GU games would provide sufficient funds along with some small non labor intensive activities.
- Jerry Emoto volunteered to be one of the SAN chairmen. Ideally, we need another co-chair and Jerry asked everyone to think about being co-chair and email him if they want to co-chair.
- Marty Swager volunteered to be Treasurer. Thanks Marty.
- Amy Mitchell volunteered to be Secretary. Thanks Amy.
- Jace Clary volunteered to be Web Master. Thanks Jace.
- Brian Thomas volunteered to be Head Prize Buyer. Thanks Brian.
- Mark Hill gave a status report for the Gonzaga concessions. He indicated that anyone working at the concessions will need training. He will be letting us know by email when the training will occur. He distributed a volunteer sheet for people to sign up to receive training. There were about 25 people that signed up – Fantastic!! There will be 8-12 people, on a rotating basis, that will be designated leads at the concessions. All volunteers will need to sign a waiver form. Mark also gave out a schedule for the men and women's games. The schedule will also be on the nchs-san.com website.
- Tim and Cindy Ecklund, Betty Nachbar, and Pete and Carol Cropper volunteered to be at NC on days before GU games to encourage senior students to work at the GU concessions. They will also sell Senior All-Nighter tickets.

- It was decided that we will not be doing any blanket sales or using Panda Express and Domino Pizza. The thought was that the effort was not worth the amount of money raised.
- Kelly Hawley will be looking into AppleBees breakfast as a fund raising activity. This requires very little effort and we receive money from each breakfast sold.
- Jerry Emoto and Marty Swager will go to STCU credit union to sign signatures for the SAN bank account.
- Jerry will get with Marty to pay for the insurance renewal.
- The NC Building has been reserved for day of the SAN and the night before for setup.
- All attendees were asked to brainstorm theme ideas for next meeting.
- It was decided that the SAN ticket prices would be \$30 up to winter break, \$40 up to spring break, and \$50 afterwards.
